ISI - Institute of Social Interaction

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The emphasis of all trainings provided by ISI – Institute of Sozial Interaction is psychodrama as a method which is learned and lived. The acting out of configurations of relationships and how they form and develop makes it possible to experience the individual emotional truth. For ISI, man and his distinct relationships to his environment take center stage. Reflecting this stand, our trainings are divided into specialized fields of job-related and organization-related consulting, which range from working with children and adults to applications in treatment and therapy.

Along with concentrating on psychodrama, our work focuses on other scenic-social approaches such as sociometry, positioning, reconstruction, practices from theatrical pedagogy and diverse methods which incorporate creative activities.

We approach our work from a bio-psycho-social point of view. Elements from additional methods (e.g. systemic, psychodynamic and behavioural-therapeutic) are also employed in order to establish a framework for integrative dialog.

ISI, as a psychodrama training institute, awards the degree of “Certified Psychodrama Practitioner (DFP/DAGG)” upon completion of basic training. Upon completion of the psychodrama-specialist training, the degree of “Certified Psychodrama Therapist (DFP/DAGG)” is awarded. Several compact trainings are offered in the specialized fields of “supervision, coaching, organizational development”, “psycho-social counseling”, “children and youth, pedagogy and therapy” and “psychotherapy”. Furthermore, a specialized training can be completed as “Certified Supervisor/Coach (DGSv)”.

The institute is located in Hamburg and was founded in 2002 by Paul Gerhard Grapentin along with some of his colleagues. After the start of the first group for psychodrama training, he was personally encouraged to pursue psychodrama training further by establishing an appropriate framework in which trainings could be held.
